Code of Conduct

At all SVST functions, whether practices, meets, or social gatherings, we expect each swimmer and their parents to behave in such a way that their actions reflect positively on the team. TSA maintains their long-standing policy that prohibits alcoholic beverages at all swim meets.

Respect all other athletes including your coaches

- cheering your team mates, helping younger swimmers
- following the directions of coaches to the best of your ability
- co-operating with adults in authority, including officials
- using polite language and exercising good manners

Respect all property

- behaving in a manner which does not result in damage
- respecting public property
- respecting the property of other swimmers

Parent's Responsibilities

- Make sure your swimmer is at practice and has the opportunity for improvement
- Encourage your swimmer to perform to the best of their ability
- Sign-out of the meet on or before the due date
- Read the emails & check the hotline
- Be prepared to help with activities of the Team, be it social, board involvement, working at meets, etc....**One of the biggest ways to make the team successful is your willingness to volunteer your time.**
